Latest guidance from the Church of England is: "Following indications that the number of people permitted to take part in a social gathering is to be reduced from 30 to six in England, we understand the new regulations will not apply to public worship or individual prayer in church buildings. The Church of England is engaging with the Government and will provide new advice to churches but we do not expect to be in a position to provide that until the week beginning September 14."

We will continue to monitor the changing circumstances carefully and will publicise last-minute changes via Facebook and email.

Face coverings: Please note that the church hall, as well as the church, are included in the categories of indoor settings where face coverings are now required.

Sundays: 13th September & 4th October 6.30pm Evening Service in the hall discussion, reflection, prayer.

27th September: the Ordination services of our curates will be streamed on line in place of our normal service.
