Together in Meditation

1 Kings 19: A sound of sheer silence

'Now there was a great wind, so strong that it was splitting mountains and breaking rocks in pieces before the LORD, but the LORD was not in the wind; and after the wind an earthquake, but the LORD was not in the earthquake; and after the earthquake a fire, but the LORD was not in the fire; and after the fire a sound of sheer silence. When Elijah heard it, he went out and stood at the entrance of the cave. Then there came a voice . . .'

In a nut shell: Sitting in silences with others, spending time in God's presence, actively listening and reflecting.

Why: Life is full on and its often difficult to make time just to be in God's presence – to listen for a heavenly voice, to reflect on what God has done and is doing. Together in mediation provides an opportunity to come together in silence, to create a space to be with God. Having a group of people to meditate with really helps to maintain focus – and the discipline of maintaining a solid time of stillness and quiet.

When and where: Starting Thursday 7th March we will be meeting at 7.30pm in the Upper Room and then on the first Thursday of the month. A short introduction, 40 minutes of sitting quietly together and a cup of tea or coffee and a chat at the end. Nothing complicated, anyone can do it, all welcome.
